Scholarship Policy

Revised : 10/30/01

Sitnasuak Foundation awards higher education scholarships to new and continuing students. Certain vocational scholarships are also awarded for specialized short-term training programs.

Scholarships are awarded each semester or quarter. The size of the scholarship depends on the funding available, the applicant's grade point average, and financial need. Applications are reviewed and selected by a committee before the beginning of each school year. Checks are mailed directly to the recipient's Financial Aid Office. Each recipient is informed in writing of the selection results every semester.

Due to a limited budget, not all applicants are awarded scholarships. It is very important that all applicants maintain the required GPA.

The maximum award amount is \$1,200 per year based on the student's current GPA. Additional funds contingent on funds available may be received for students attending summer terms.

Students who have just been discharged from the military may use their military school background to receive a scholarship. The student must be honorably discharged to receive \$400 for the first semester or quarter.

Part-Time Students

Sitnasuak Foundations reimburses students who attend college part-time (less than 12 credit hours). A student will be reimbursed \$200 per semester.

Vocational Training Policy

Sitnasuak Foundation will provide financial assistance to students attending vocational training. The award amount is \$400 per semester or \$800 per year.

Requirements and Qualifications

1. Must be accepted to an accredited college or vocational program.
2. Must demonstrate financial need after other funding sources have been considered.
3. Must have earned a GED or high school diploma with a 2.0 grade point average.
4. Must complete the scholarship application and mail it to the address above.
5. For first time high school graduate applicants, an official high school transcript and letter of reference must accompany the application. The letter should describe the student's involvement in the community as well as accomplishments.
6. For continuing college students, an official college transcript or copy of the previous semester grades must accompany the application. If grades have not yet been posted, please see the registrar office about having an official transcript mail directly to us as soon as they are available.
7. It is the applicant's responsibility to send Verification of Enrollment to the Sitnasuak Foundation. Once the verification has been received, a scholarship check will be mailed to your college's financial aid office.
8. Scholarships are awarded based on current grade point average.
9. Full-time undergraduate students must maintain a 2.0 GPA and complete 12 credits.
10. If an application is incomplete, it will be sent back for completion. Any applications postmarked after the deadline will not be considered.
11. The deadlines for full-time students are:
